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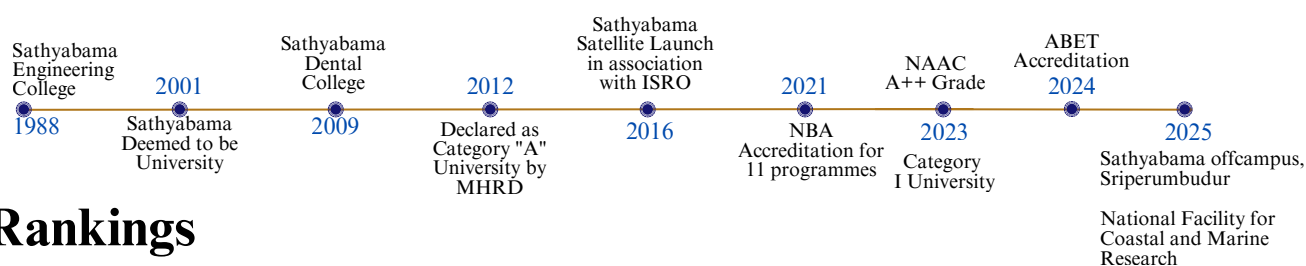
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About the Institution

Class Timings:

9.00 A.M. to 3.15 P.M. for all UG and PG programmes

Attendance / Leave / On Duty:

- Attendance will be taken for every class hour and the semester attendance percentage is calculated automatically from the class attendance
- Students should maintain 80% attendance for all theory courses and 100% attendance for all laboratory courses in a semester to appear for the End Semester Examinations
- Attendance is compulsory for both the Continuous Assessment Examinations
- Leave may be availed for genuine reasons with prior permission from mentor
- Half day leave or permission is not permitted, however, in the case of emergencies, if the parent accompanies the student to leave the campus on a genuine health related problems, students shall be allowed to leave. In the case of any other unfortunate incidents such as loss of blood relation, such request will be considered upon the verification from the parent over phone
- Permission will be given for the student to enter the campus one hour before the commencement of the afternoon session End Semester Examinations
- Students may avail a maximum of six days of On Duty (OD) per semester for attending seminars, workshops, symposiums, and similar academic events, subject to prior approval from the Head of the Department and submission of valid attendance certificates or proof of participation upon reporting back
- Individual student attendance reports will be sent to parents every day through SMS notifications.

Identity Card:

- Each student will be provided with an Identity Card with his / her photo and name on it
- It is mandatory to wear the ID card inside the Campus and also while representing our institution in other College / University events such as sports, cultural and other academic activities
- Day scholars are not allowed to get into the bus for a destination other than mentioned as the boarding point in the ID Card and also not permitted to enter the hostel premises
- In case of loss or damage of ID card, duplicate identity card may be issued on submitting an application and payment of ₹ 500 - (Card + pouch + lanyard) or ₹ 250 - (Only Card) in the Student Help Desk

Mentor:

- Each student is allotted with a faculty adviser called as mentor for academic & non-academic guidance after enrolment
- In case of any queries/ issues, student shall contact his / her mentor

- One Student ambassador (topper of the class) representing the voice of students from each class

Re-examination:

- In case the student is not satisfied with the end semester result, they can apply for revaluation within the stipulated time mentioned in the website after the revaluation announcement
