1. About the Practice

Sathyabama is an inclusive Institution and works with the motto of "Education for all." The Anbu scholarship scheme was initiated by our Chancellor Dr. Mariazeena Johnson to help the poor and needy pursue higher education. This initiative gives hundreds of deserving students the opportunity to continue their education.

Sathyabama aims to create a society in which everyone has access to equal opportunities and the right to a good life. The Institution believes that education is an instrument to improve the socioeconomic status of people living in poverty and develop rural economies. The Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology's mission is to provide quality education to students while developing qualified manpower for the nation. The core ideology of the Institution is inclusivity, and this scholarship programme intends to reflect the value system of the Institution. The idea of the programme is to give opportunities for the underprivileged communities to develop and succeed in life.

The Institution offers courses in engineering, science, technology, arts, management, dentistry, nursing and law. It offers educational opportunities for underprivileged, and marginalized people living in poverty, children of destitute women, children of war widows, children with special needs, children of prison inmates and girl children who are victims of acid attacks. Apart from the scholarship for underrepresented groups, the Institution also appreciates and rewards students with excellent performance in their academics. 10-30% of the Scholarship is given to meritorious students based on their ranks in end semester examinations. The Institution has established Sathyabama IAS academy to provide free coaching for civil service aspirants. This academy

enables students to pursue civil services coaching by expert trainers, retired civil servants and bureaucrats. Our alumni in the civil services are also invited to create awareness and motivate students to crack civil service examinations.

2 ANBU SCHOLASHIP

The Anbu Scholarship is offered to meritorious children who lack financial support to continue their education. The Institution is associated with many trusts and foundations which involve in identification and selection of meritorious, deserving, needy and capable students with higher degree of transparency. Agaram Foundation, World Vision, India vision, Ability Foundation, Banyan, NAAM, Maatram, and Tamilnadu Blind Association are some of such organizations through which the students apply for this scheme.



Our Chancellor with the Acid Attack victims who were offered Full Scholarship to pursue higher education at our Institution



3 DR. JEPPIAAR REMIBAI MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

Dr. Jeppiaar Remibai Merit Scholarship is given to students who excel in academics and emerge as toppers in exams in each branch. This scholarship is provided to motivate and encourage the students to work hard and perform well in academics so that they are entitled to the reward in the form of a scholarship. Every year, the toppers are awarded with Dr. Jeppiaar Remibai merit scholarship. The first, second, and third toppers are given a 30%, 20% and 10% discount on their tuition fees, respectively. This scholarship is based only on performance and does not depend on the student's background. It encourages students to give their best and work towards achieving the best in their lives.

Minimum Score of 75% is mandatory to avail Scholarship

Ranks will be given based on Total Score

II Year

• 10% Tuition fee Waiver for all the Top 3 rank Holders & Full waiver of Examination fee

III Year

• 20% Tuition fee Waiver for the Top rank Holder, 10% Tuition fee Waiver for the 2nd and 3rd rank Holders & Full waiver of Examination fee

IV Year

• 30% Tuition fee Waiver for the Top rank Holder, 20% Tuition fee Waiver for the 2nd rank holder and 10% tuition fee waiver for the 3rd rank Holder & Full waiver of Examination fee & Project Fees
