The Internal Quality Assurance Cell meeting was held online on 10/04/2020 at 10.30 a.m. to overcome the situation during the initial stage of pandemic and was attended by the Deans of the various schools and the IQAC members.

- 1. The Vice Chancellor welcomed the gathering. The IQAC Coordinator was asked to brief the activities of IQAC since the previous meeting followed by the agenda of the meeting for the discussion for the meeting.
- 2. Owing to the pandemic, the Vice Chancellor urged the faculty members to update their skills and go through as many workshops and FDPs as possible.
- 3. In order to venture into Next generation technologies, IQAC has recommended on various FDP and skill developed programs.
- 4. A number of programs were conducted for the faculties on extended technologies like Augmented Reality, Virtual Reality, Block Chain Technology, Data Science and Artificial Intelligence.
- 5. 25 faculty members were identified to take up the six months program in Artificial Intelligence course. The selected faculty members will have to go through extensive training on the AI-module.
- 6. The Deans and Heads of the departments were instructed to inform all the faculty members to use the ICT tools and LMS effectively for their subject delivery via ZOOM platform to conduct classes.
- 7. The Vice Chancellor instructed the Placement cell to conduct the placement training and mock interviews online.
- Faculty members have been encouraged to enroll for online courses such as Coursera, MOOC, NPTEL, AICTE Atal, Udemy, etc.
- 9. The Deans and Heads were asked to plan to conduct the project reviews online and complete the same by June2020 for all the final year students.
- 10. The faculty members were asked to conduct mock exams for the students. The observation and issues if any, had to be resolved before the end semester online exams.
- 11. The Vice Chancellor asked the Controller of Examination to initiate online course







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completion certificate.

- 12. The Jeppiaar Research Forum was initiated to encourage the faculty members to conduct seminars, workshops and research activities. These activities motivated the peer group to come up with more research initiatives.
- Supported in the establishment of academic collaborations between European institutions thereby Initiated Student and Faculty exchange Program through Erasmus plus and Mevlana Exchange Programs.
- 14. UGC expert committee visited the institution and granted UGC 12B status.
- 15. A purchase committee has been formed under the Vice Chancellor which will oversee all the purchases and vendor management of the institution.
- 16. The Centre for Professional and Career Advancement was inaugurated to promote short term certificate programs for working professionals.

- The Vice Chancellor welcomed the gathering and wished all a new successful academic year.
- The Vice Chancellor welcomed the new members of IQAC. The restructured composition of IQAC was presented and Composition appended.
- The functions and role of IQAC in sustaining the quality of the academic programmes were highlighted.
- The IQAC coordinator was asked to brief the activities of IQAC since the previous meeting.
- After the report, the IQAC coordinator discussed the agenda for the meeting.
- The Vice Chancellor mentioned that the revised 2019 Syllabus Regulation for the Engineering programmes has been implemented keeping in mind the below:
  - As per AICTE norms, total number of credits for the UG engineering programs is reduced to 160.
  - The weightage of the courses for basic sciences, program core, program electives and open electives has been allocated based on the AICTE model curriculum.
- The Vice Chancellor also reiterated that the curriculum and syllabus has been designed as per the Program Outcomes (PO) and Programme Specific Outcomes (PSO) and the feedback from the stakeholders.
- An orientation programme on Outcome based education for the first year students has to be conducted by August 2019.
- The deans have been requested to submit the data for UGC 12 B status.







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- It was informed that the student's feedback will be taken on regular basis and the analysis has to be shared with deans and heads. The heads and deans were requested to convene regular meetings to review the revised syllabus.
- New programmes for the upcoming academic year were proposed and the same was presented to the Board of Management for their approval.
- The programmes included were:
  - B.E. Computer Science Engineering with specialization in Artificial Intelligence.
  - B.E. Computer Science Engineering with specialization in Data Science
  - B.E. Computer Science Engineering with specialization in Internet of Things
  - B. Sc Computer Science with specialization in Artificial Intelligence
  - B.Sc Medical Lab Technology
- All the deans and heads were requested to be prepared for Academic Audit which has been Scheduled on August
- The departments of ECE and Mechanical would be expecting the visit for NBA accreditation (as a part of Washington accord signatory renewal). Hence the respective School Deans and the Heads are requested to prepare the required documentation for the upcoming NBA expert team visit, which is scheduled tentatively in the first week of September 2019.
- The departments are asked to conduct student induction programs for the first year students and the IQAC has to conduct the faculty induction programs for the newly recruited faculty.
- The departments were also asked to conduct FDPs, workshops and conferences in order to equip
- IQAC will initiate the data collection and entry required for NIRF ranking.
