Greetings from NITTTR Chennai!

All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) launched the National Initiative for Technical Teachers Training (NITTT) for inductee teachers, this shall apply to all the teachers working in technical institutions (as defined in Section 2(h) of AICTE Act 1987) whose programmes have been given recognition by AICTE and also universities (including deemed to be universities) imparting technical education (as defined in Section 2(g) of AICTE Act 1987) for such of their programmes which have been approved by AICTE, New Delhi. As a part of the NITTT Programme, the inductee teachers need to complete the eight modules, followed by industrial training and mentoring.

NITTTR Chennai has been designated as the coordinating institute for the successful rollout of the programme. As on date, a total of 36,898 learners enrolled for the various modules of this scheme. After successful completion of eight modules, they need to be mentored under a senior faculty member. As a part of the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020, the young teachers need to be motivated and energized. As per Para 15.11 of NEP, 2020, National Mission for Mentoring is to be established, with a large pool of outstanding senior faculty to provide mentoring/professional support to the inductee teachers and in turn establish the sustainable educational ecosystem.

Therefore, as desired by the AICTE and the Ministry of Education, Govt of India, a five days' NITTT Mentor workshop is proposed to be conducted fresh through online mode by NITTTR Chennai along with other NITTTR's. I request you to nominate senior faculty members in the cadre of Associate Professor / Professor from the Engineering Colleges and the Principals from Polytechnique System to act as a mentor to the inductee teachers. The series of mentor workshop is scheduled in the month of June and July, 2021 and request them to register in the portal www.nittt.ac.in. Certificates will be issued only to the candidates who successful complete the course and get registered as the mentors in the portal (www.nittt.ac.in).
