


B.Sc Syllabus

The B.Sc syllabus was completely revised and the suggestions of the Members were included in the syllabus. The members has approved the syllabus and will be followed for B.Sc Chemistry, 2021 -2024 batch after approval from academic council. According to the suggestion of the members the credits of the courses has been uniformly given – Theory courses – 3 credits, Practical courses – 2 credits, Professional training – 3 credits and Project work – 4 credits.
