Brief Description of Institution

Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology, founded in 1988 by Dr. Jeppiaar, is a NAAC A++ Grade, Category I Deemed University under UGC Act, 1956. Led by Chancellor Dr. Mariazeena Johnson and President Dr. Marie Johnson, it offers multidisciplinary programmes across Engineering, Science, Technology, Architecture, Dental Science, Pharmacy, Nursing, Law, Management, Arts, Physiotherapy, and Education. Ten UG engineering programmes and one PG programme (MBA) hold NBA accreditation. Five programmes – B.E. Computer Science and Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, and B.Tech Biotechnology – are accredited by ABET, USA, establishing global benchmarking. Sathyabama ranks 53rd among Indian universities (NIRF), features in QS and Times Higher Education World Rankings. A landmark achievement is the launch of SATHYABAMASAT with ISRO in 2016.
